

Travel vaccinations

What NHS vaccinations are available from Fairfield Medical Centre?

We can provide a limited range of NHS available vaccinations (which are sometimes recommended for travel) where they are not up to date (subject to availability) - including:

- Hepatitis A
- Typhoid
- Diphtheria/tetanus/polio

If you are currently registered with the practice and believe that you need one of the above vaccinations - please call to book a 10 minute nurse appointment. You will need to tell us where you plan to visit when you book the appointment.

We are sorry - but our nurses cannot provide:

- advice about what other travel vaccines you may need
- advice about malaria
- private travel vaccinations

How can I find out what vaccinations I have had already?
